



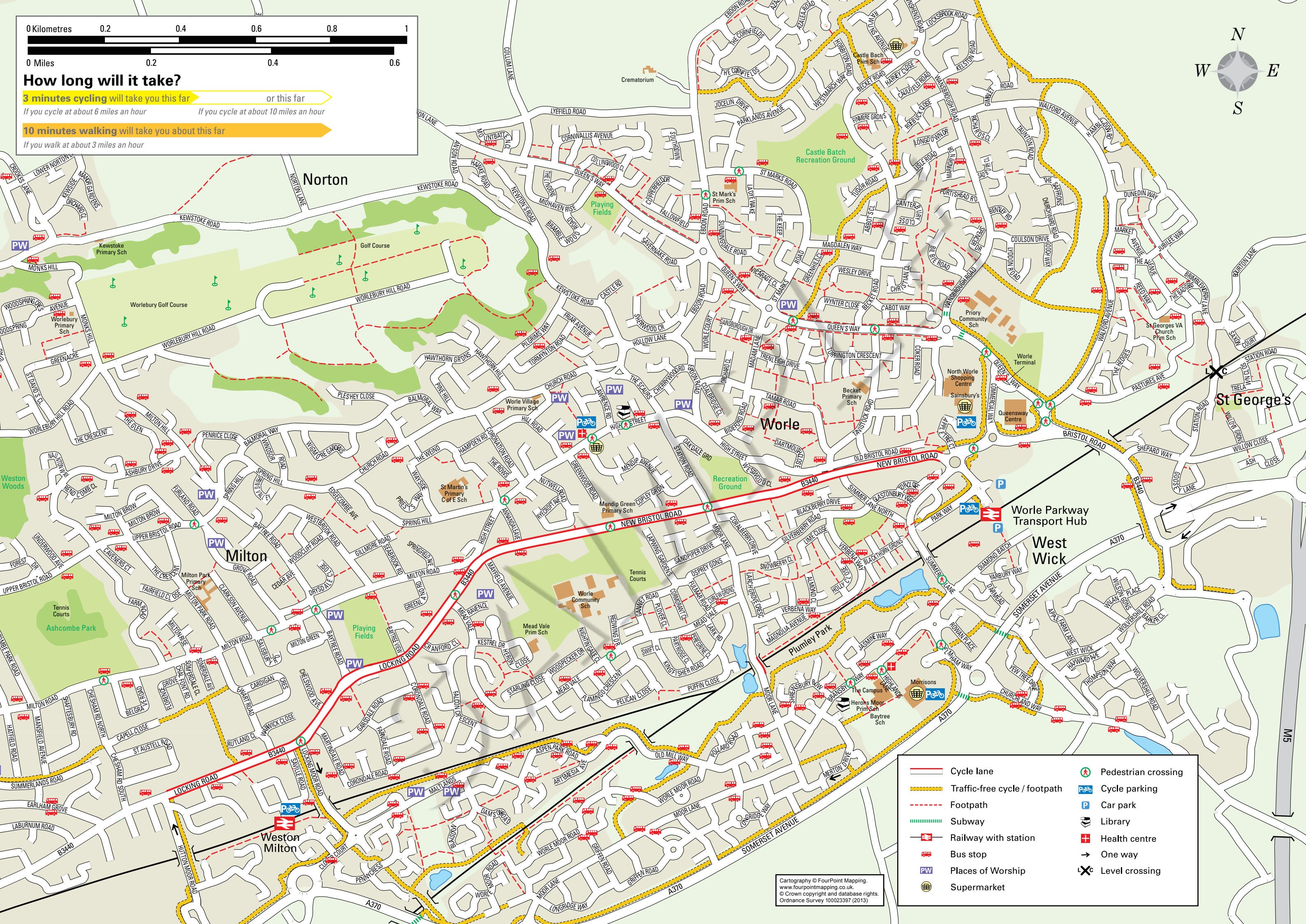
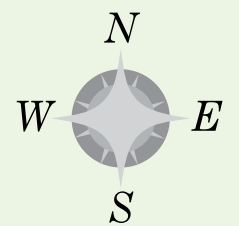
How long will it take?

Walk it, bike it, scoot it

The **active travel to school** project gives pupils, parents and teachers information and support to encourage safe and healthy active journeys to school. It aims to help people choose to walk, cycle, scoot or take public transport on their journeys. This helps us all to stay fitter and healthier and reduces congestion and pollution caused by cars.

The project focuses on those who live within easy walking and cycling distance to school.



What is active travel?

Active travel includes walking, cycling, scooting and skateboarding.

It is any form of travel which involves doing some exercise. If possible choose to walk, cycle or scoot to school so your children get exercise everyday. This contributes to the government's recommended one hour of physical exercise daily for kids and young people.

Why choose active travel?

The school journey is a perfect opportunity for children to learn about their local area, develop wider social networks and gain independence.

Choosing to walk, cycle, scoot or skate to school will help your child's mental and physical health. A short walk or cycle to school contributes towards the recommended hour of physical activity that children need daily. And, teachers find that pupils who walk and cycle arrive at school more relaxed, alert and ready to start the day than those who travel by car.

Encouraging children to walk, cycle and scoot will reduce congestion and pollution around the school gates.

Top tips for active travel:

- Plan your journey, use quieter roads where possible.
- Wear bright colours or hi-viz clothing to be safe and seen.
- On bikes, wear a helmet. Use lights and hi-viz if it's dark.
- Accompany young children. As they get older they will be able to be more independent.
- If you live too far away to walk the whole distance, try parking a few streets away and then walking from there to the school gates.
